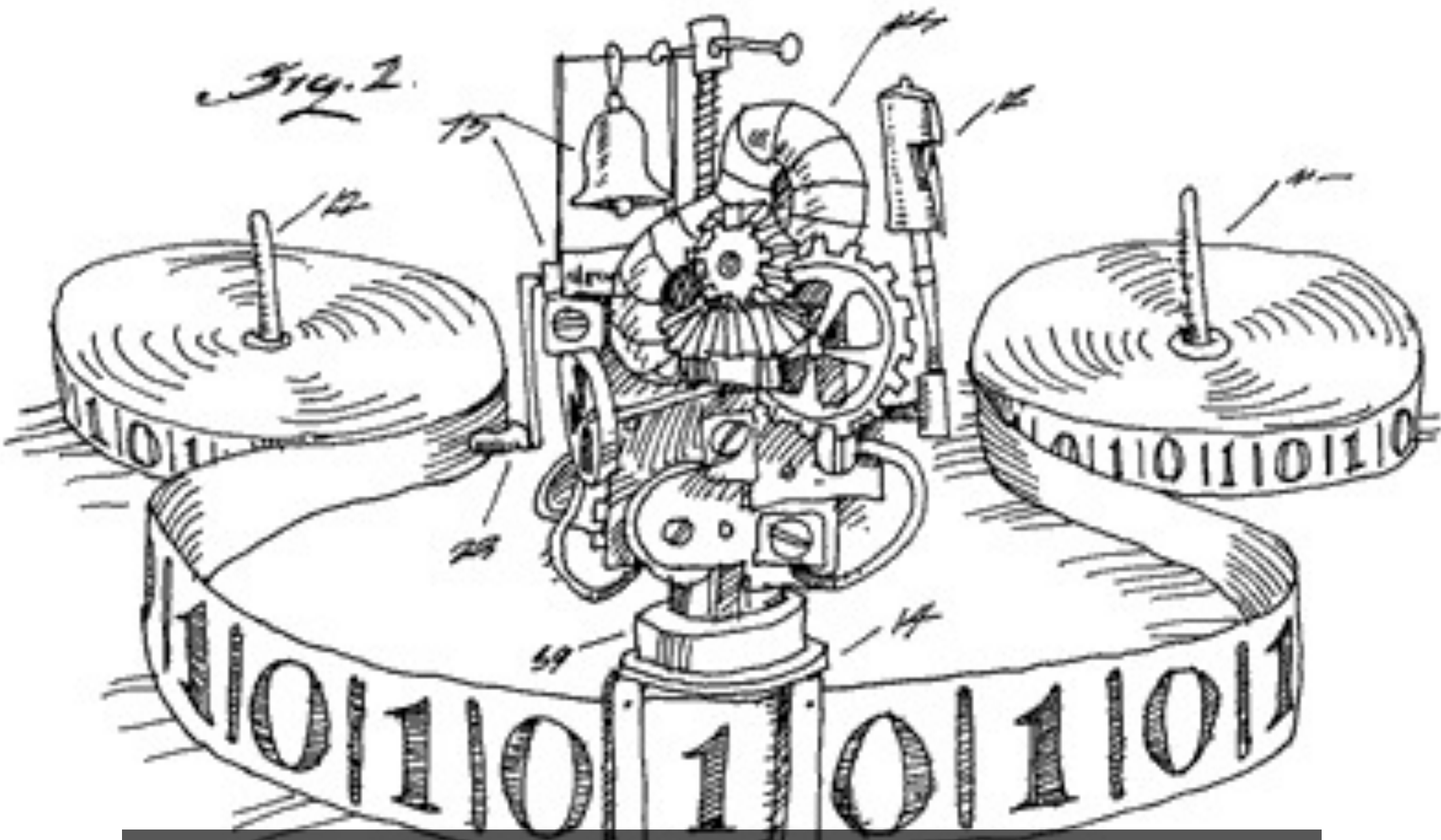
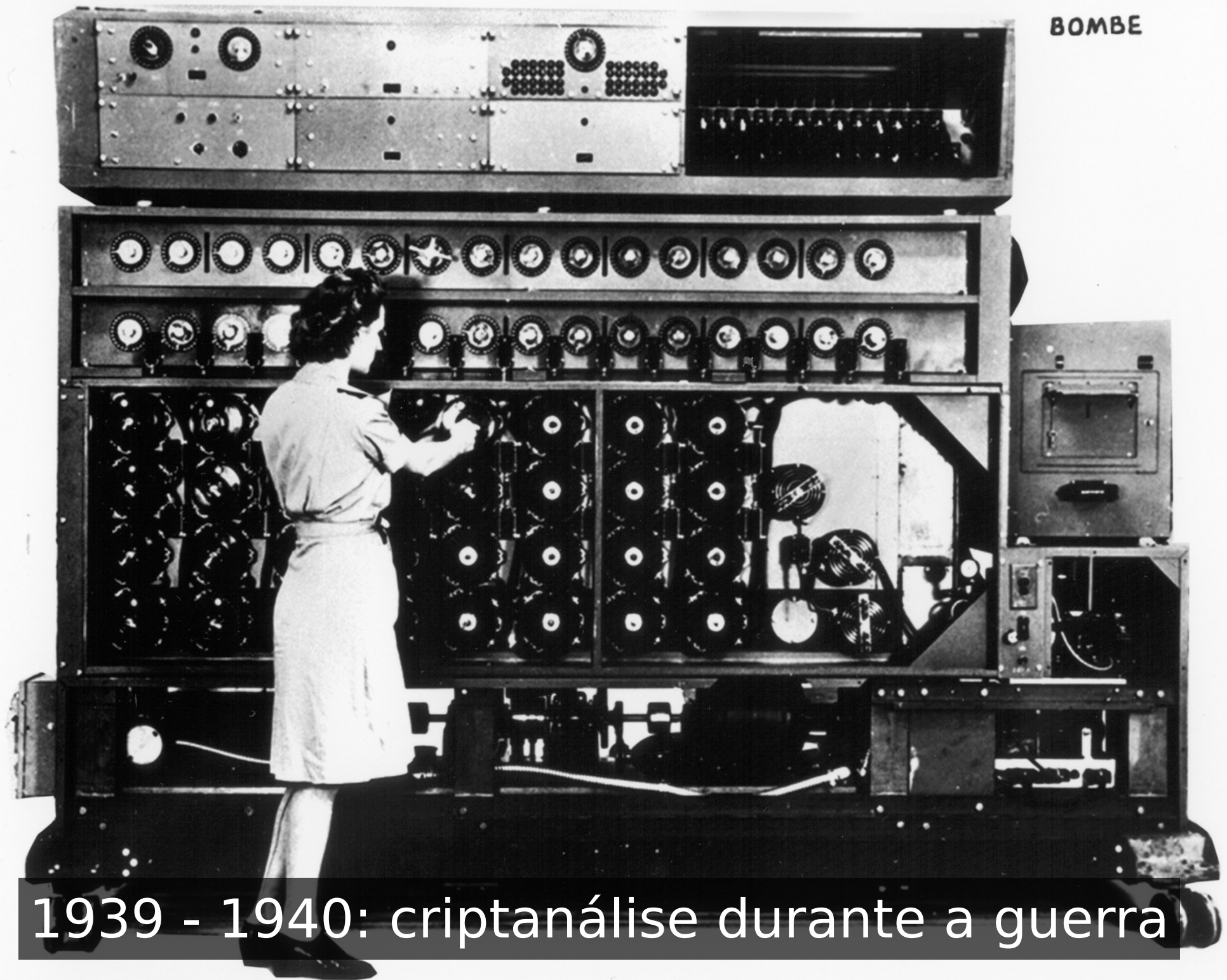

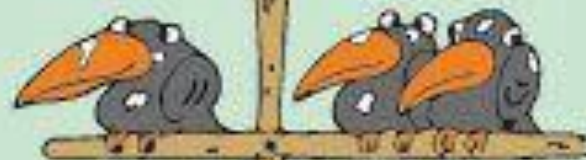

SUBJECT: AR 15-6 Report – Compromise of Classified Information to Wikileaks

2. (U//FOUO) Accession into the Army.

a. (U//FOUO) As part of PFC Manning's accession into the Army, he reported to the Fort Meade Military Entrance Processing Station (MEPS) on or about 31 August 2007. The MEPS processing includes a medical examination which is documented on a DD Form 2807-1 (Encl Q23), Report of Medical History. The form includes a series of questions covering behavioral health issues. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

b. (U//FOUO) The enlistment criteria are set out in AR 601-210, Active and Reserve Components Enlistment Program, 7 June 2007 and AR 40-501, Standards of Medical Fitness, 29 May 2007. Paragraph (b) (6) of AR 40-501 lists the criteria for which (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) would disqualify an individual from military service. Specifically, it states (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) AR 40-501, paragraph (b) (6), 29 May 2007 (Encl Q54)).

c. (U//FOUO) Despite the behavioral health issues identified in paragraphs 1.b.(1) and 1.c.(3) above, PFC Manning answered (b) (6), (b) (7) in the negative. There is no other indication of behavioral health review or screening in PFC Manning's enlistment documents. (PFC Manning's DD Form 2807-1, Report of Medical History, 31 August 2007 (Encl J1)).

d. (U//FOUO) On 26 September 2007, PFC Manning began his four year enlistment in the Active Army. (Enlistment Docs (Encl J1)).

3. (U//FOUO) MOS Classification. PFC Manning's enlistment was for service as a Military Occupational Specialty (MOS) 35F, Intelligence Analyst. (See DA Form 3286 (Annex A), dated 26 Sep 2007, U.S. Army Delayed Enlistment Program (Encl J1); DA Form 3286 (Annex B), dated 2 Oct 2007, United States Army Enlistment Program (Encl J1)). In order to be granted the MOS of 35F, PFC Manning needed to meet the requirements set out in Department of the Army (DA) Pam 611-21. The requirements included: a score of 101 or higher on the ST (skilled technical) portion of the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB); eligibility for a Top Secret/Sensitive Compartmented Information (TS/SCI) security clearance; a high school or equivalent degree; no criminal conviction for anything other than minor traffic violations; U.S. citizenship; and the absence of any no close ties to foreign countries within whose boundaries physical or mental coercion is known to be common. PFC Manning met all the requirements and had an ST score of 128. (ERB, 29 May 2010 (Encl J1)).

4. (U//FOUO) Basic Training. PFC Manning attended basic training at Fort Leonard Wood, MO from 5 October 2007 until 6 April 2007. His training lasted six months for a



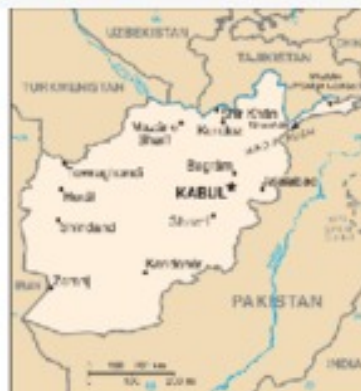

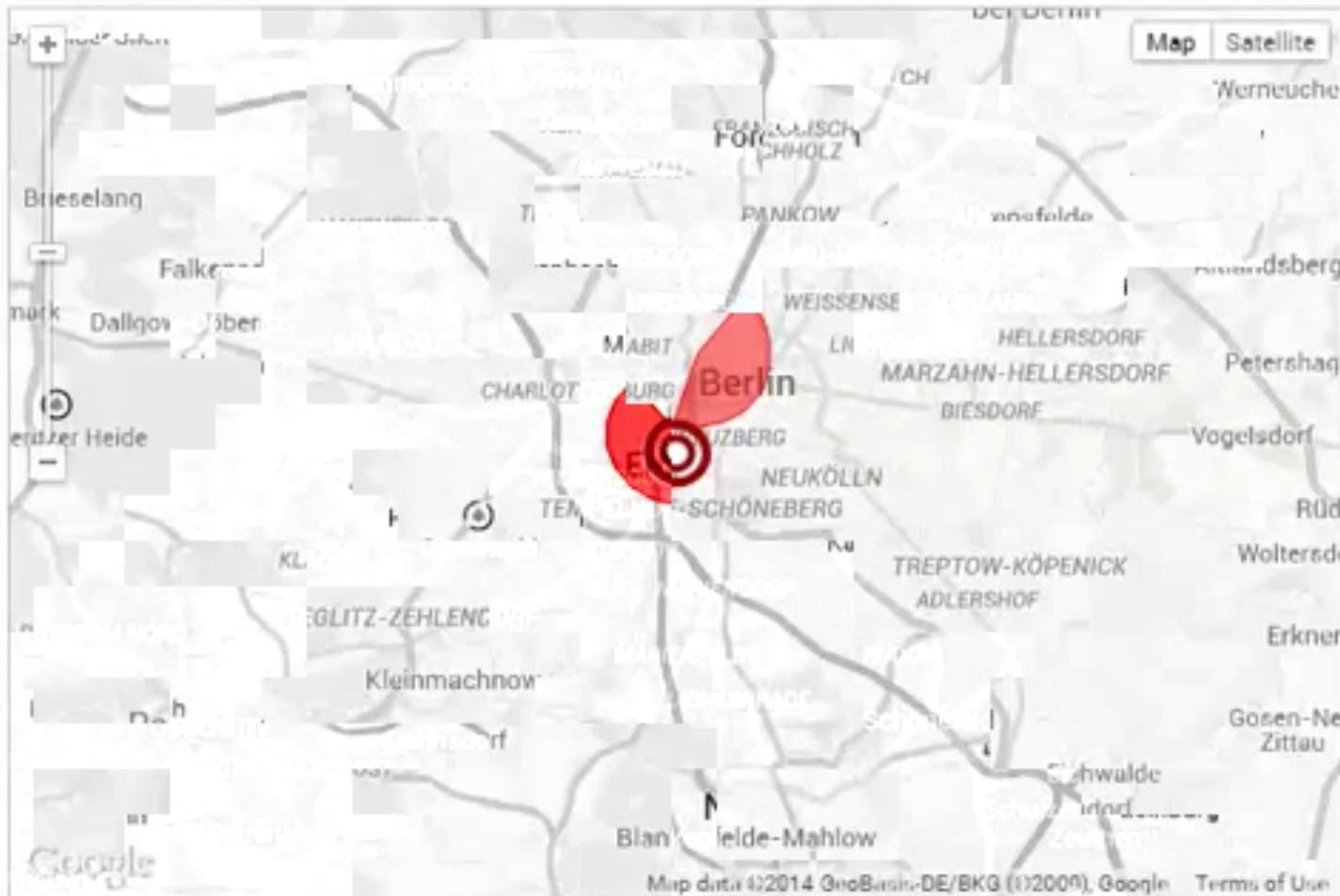

Suspeitamos que seja esta a mesma causa do **bloqueio** feito pela Net e pela Embratel ao CMI. Houve relato de **bloqueio** feito pela TIM, mas não tivemos mais informações sobre esta provedora.

Vamos se por todos os informarmos de que os cmi's, estão criando um site com a descrição dos fatos sobre a CENSURA que o CMI vem sofrendo desde Abril deste ano. PORNOGRAFIA INFANTIL

Google e MPF fecham acordo para combater pornografia infantil

A Google Brasil e o Ministério Público Federal em São Paulo resolveram assinar um Termo de Ajustamento de Conduta. O acordo, que será feito na manhã desta quarta-feira (2/7), em Brasília, na CPI da Pedofilia, vai permitir o acesso a 3.200 álbuns do site de relacionamentos Orkut. Eles incentivam a pornografia infantil na internet. As páginas foram denunciadas pela ONG Safernet Brasil.

Para os procuradores da República Sergio Gardenghi Suiama e Adriana Scordamaglia, que representarão o MPF na assinatura do TAC, o tratado é um avanço na proteção dos direitos de 30 milhões de brasileiros, usuários do serviço Orkut.

De acordo com os itens do TAC, a Google passará a reportar automaticamente ao Ministério Público todos os casos de pornografia infantil encontrados no Orkut e também desenvolverá filtros para impedir a publicação dessas imagens. “Acreditamos que essas medidas tornarão o Orkut um ambiente mais seguro para todos os seus usuários e agilizarão o combate aos crimes cibernéticos”, afirmam os procuradores da República Sergio Gardenghi Suiama e Adriana Scordamaglia.

Confira alguns itens do Termo de Ajustamento de Conduta

1. Notificação automática de todas as ocorrências de pornografia infantil detectadas em perfis e comunidades do Orkut, para que o MPF possa abrir as devidas investigações;
2. Preservação de todos os dados necessários às investigações pelo prazo mínimo de seis meses e o fornecimento desses dados ao Ministério Público e à polícia brasileira, mediante autorização judicial;
3. Preservação dos conteúdos publicados por usuários do Orkut pelo mesmo prazo, e fornecimento desses conteúdos às autoridades públicas mediante autorização judicial;
4. Cumprimento integral da legislação brasileira, no que se refere a crimes cibernéticos praticados por brasileiros ou por meio de conexões de internet efetuadas no Brasil;
5. Reformulação do setor de atendimento ao consumidor da Google, que fica obrigado a responder, no prazo de até 15 dias úteis, todas as reclamações formuladas por e-mail ou via postal, de usuários do Orkut prejudicados pela criação de perfis e comunidades falsas ou ofensivas;
6. Desenvolvimento de tecnologia eficiente de filtragem e implementação de moderação humana para impedir a publicação de fotografias e imagens de pornografia infantil no serviço Orkut;
7. Desenvolvimento de ferramenta por meio da qual o hotline conveniado Safernet (www.denunciar.org.br) encaminhe até 500 denúncias únicas/dia para que os funcionários da empresa analisem, retirem o conteúdo criminoso do ar, informem ao MPF quais continham indícios de pornografia infantil, racismo e outros crimes de ódio, e preservem todas as provas;

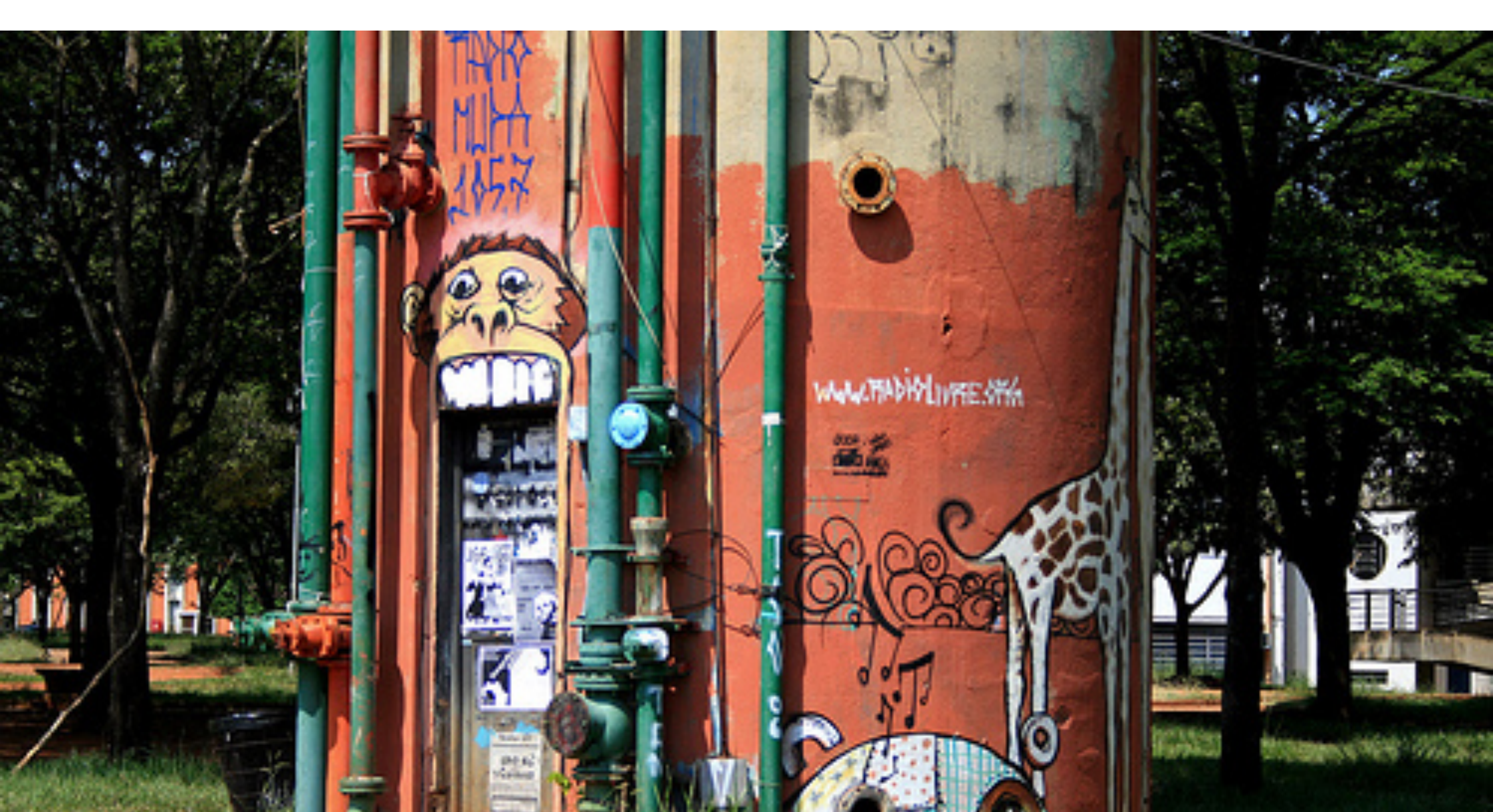

A 1ª Vara Criminal de São Bernardo do Campo (SP) determinou às operadoras de telefonia móvel o bloqueio do aplicativo WhatsApp, pelo período de 48 horas, em todo o país. O prazo passa a contar a partir da 0 hora desta quinta-feira (17). O serviço vai ficar bloqueado tanto na rede de internet móvel (3G e 4G) quanto na internet fixa (wi-fi).

O Sindicato Nacional das Empresas de Telefonia e de Serviço Móvel Celular e Pessoal

(SindiTelebrasil) confirmou que as empresas associadas à entidade receberam a intimação judicial na tarde desta quarta-feira (16) e que já cumpriram o determinação judicial. O SindiTelebrasil afirma, no entanto, que não foi o autor do requerimento para o bloqueio do aplicativo. A decisão foi

proferida em um procedimento criminal, que corre em segredo de justiça.

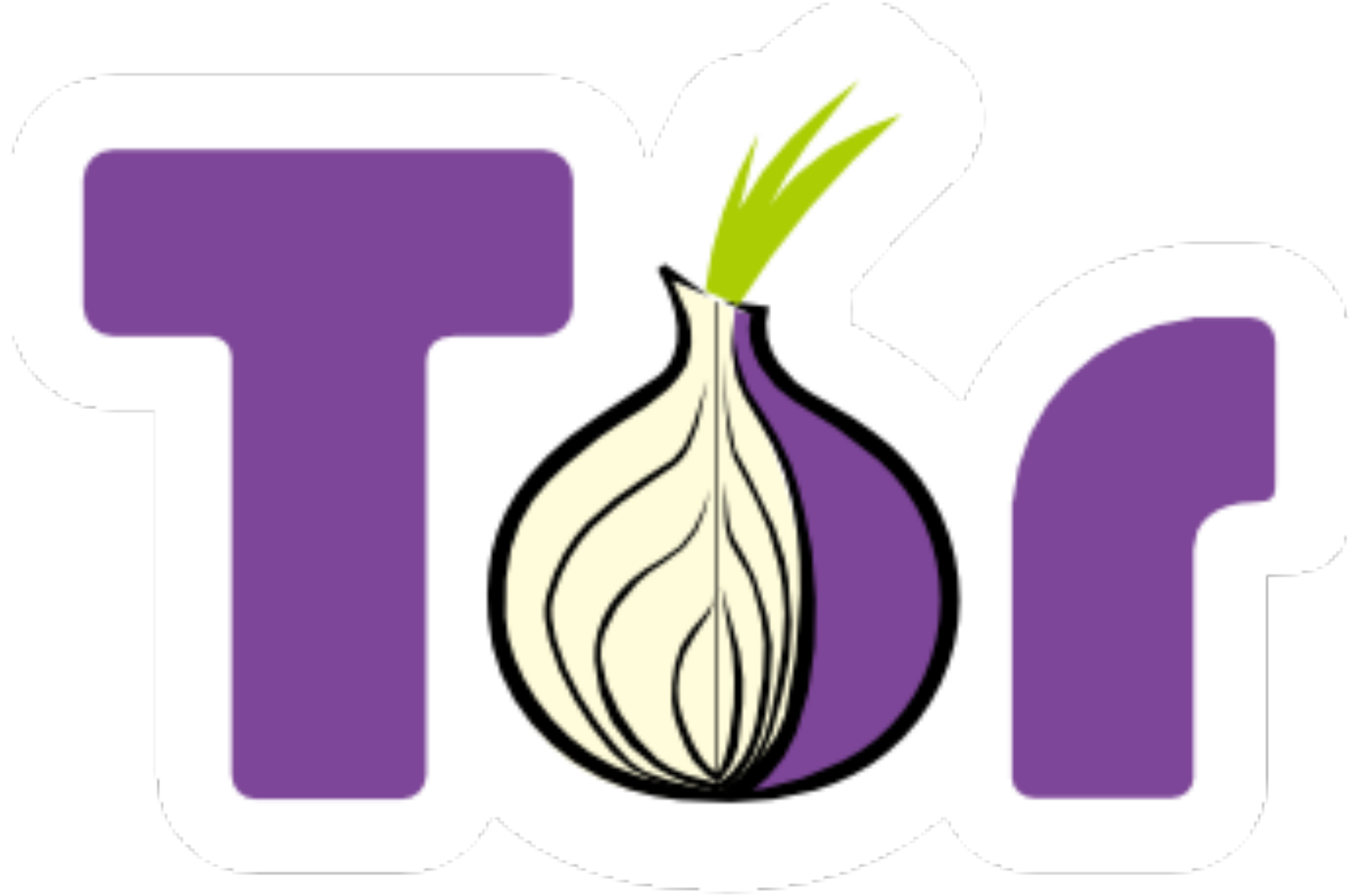
O vice-presidente do Facebook na América Latina, o argentino Diego Dzorán, foi preso preventivamente nesta terça-feira (1/3) em São Paulo. A detenção, feita pela equipe da Polícia Federal da Delegacia de Repressão Entorpecentes, atendeu a mandado de prisão por descumprimento de ordem judicial emitido pelo juiz criminal de Lagarto (SE) Marcel Maia Montalvão.

De acordo com a PF, as ordens judiciais foram proferidas com o objetivo de obter provas para um processo investigação de crime organizado e tráfico de drogas.

O advogado **Davi Tangerino**, que representa o WhatsApp, do qual o Facebook é dono, afirmou à **ConJur** que a prisão de Dzorán se deu devido ao fato de rede social não fornecer o conteúdo de mensagens trocadas por meio do aplicativo de mensagens.




Tangerino se mostrou surpreso com a prisão do executivo. O WhatsApp explicou ao juiz Montalvão que a tecnologia de encriptação do aplicativo não permite o acesso a dados de conversas dos usuários e o juiz, por também ter função de delegado, deu ordem de prisão por descumprimento de ordem judicial emitida por técnicos.

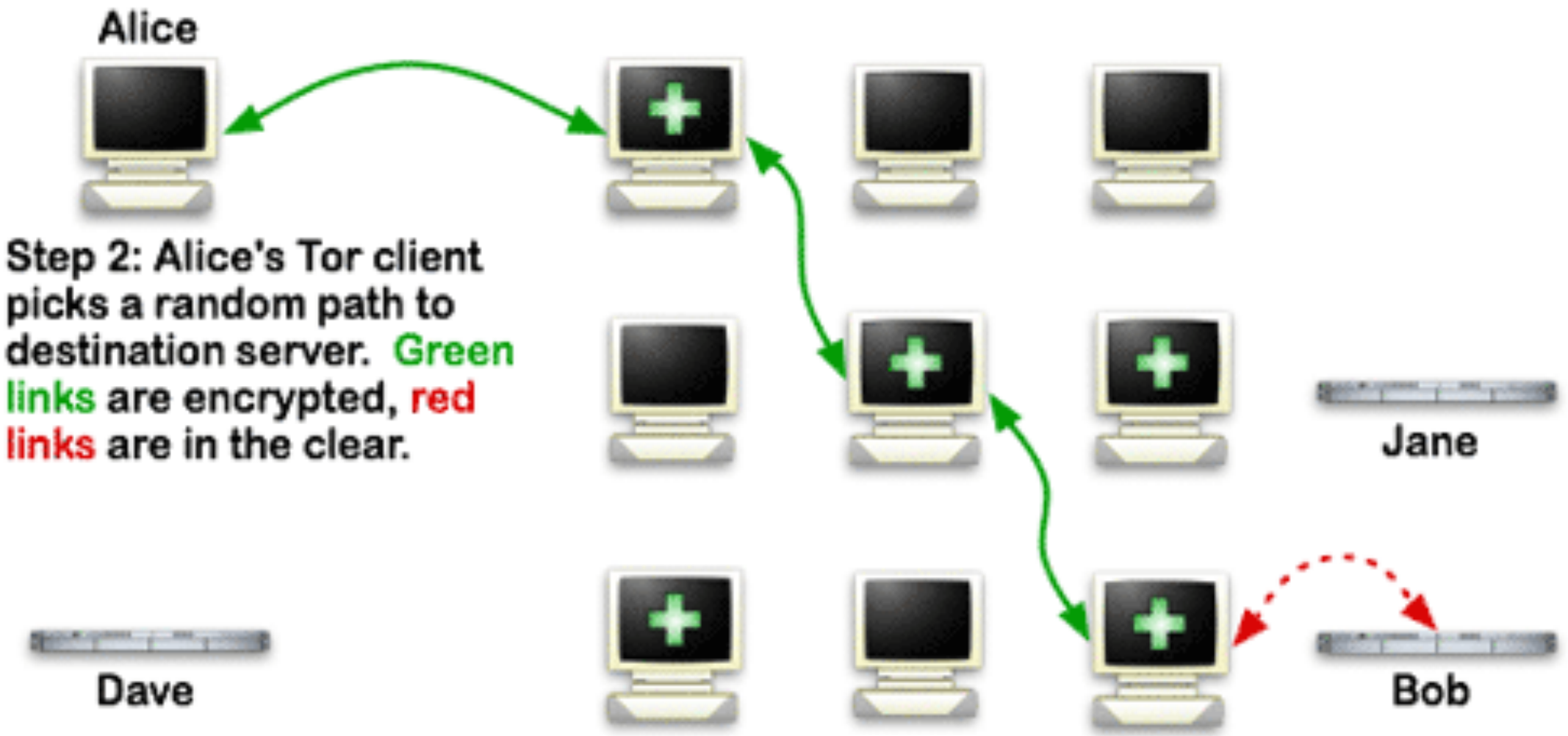

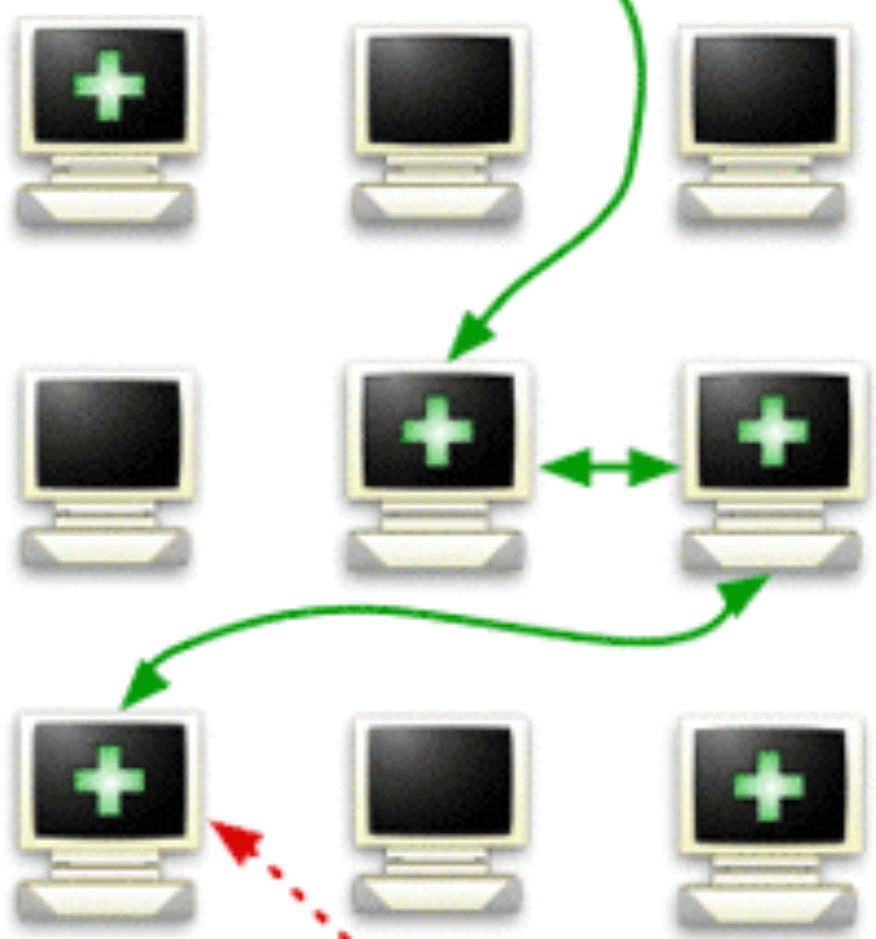

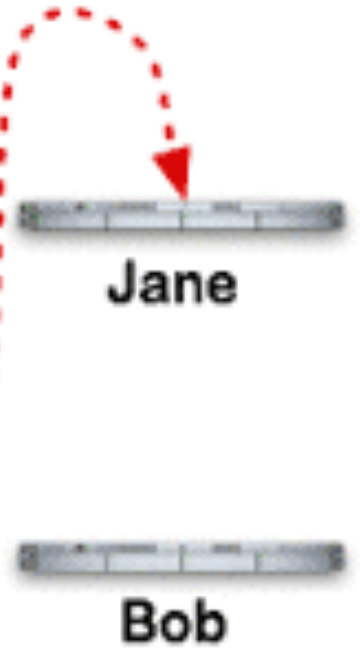
Step 2: Alice's Tor client picks a random path to destination server. **Green links** are encrypted, **red links** are in the clear.

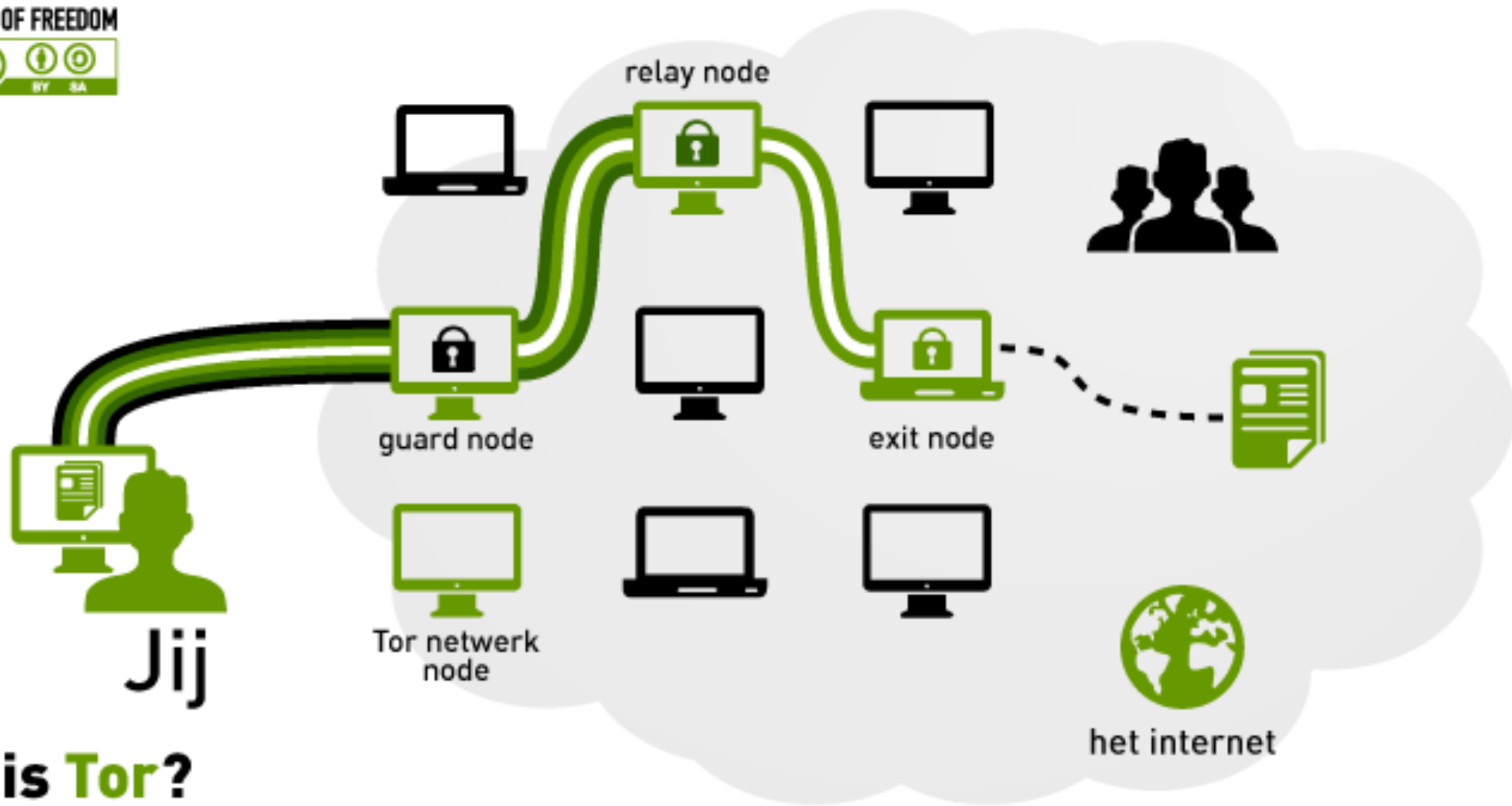
How Tor Works: 3
