***** Bernoulli 50: Collection of Videos and Interviews**

As part of celebrating and recording our Society's history on the occasion of its Golden Jubilee, the Society curated a collection of several videos over the last year. ***** General Assembly of the Bernoulli Society 2025**

In a break with tradition, the next General Assembly of the Bernoulli Society –including the transfer of the Bernoulli book– will take place at the SPA 2025 meeting rather than the ISI World Statistics Congress (October 5–9, 2025). This is due to the ISI WSC being exceptionally moved to autumn instead of its usual timing in the summer, thus not being well-aligned with the Society's administrative calendar.

***** New Researcher Award in Probability Theory – Call for Applications**

The Bernoulli Society welcomes applications to the 2026 New Researcher Award. Eligible candidates are active researchers in Probability Theory who obtained the PhD degree on or after June 30, 2020, and who are regular members of the Bernoulli Society. An extension may be given to those having had disruptions after receiving the PhD, such as parenthood. Diversity among the awardees is one of the Society's goals, and therefore women and members of under-represented groups are particularly encouraged to apply. ***** David G. Kendall Award for Young Researchers – Call for Nominations**

The Award Committee invites nominations for the Bernoulli Society-Royal Statistical Society David G. Kendall Award for Young Researchers. The award is in honor of David G. Kendall, who was the first president of the Bernoulli Society, and was awarded the Guy Medal in Silver (1955) and in Gold (1981) of the RSS. The 2025 edition of the award is organized for young researchers in Probability Theory. Nominees should be researchers with significant achievements and great potential in their research field, who are members of either the Bernoulli Society or the Royal Statistical Society, and who obtained their PhD after January 1, 2017. Nominations from under-represented groups are particularly encouraged. The nomination process is open from 1 April 2025 and closes on 30 June 2025. The complete call can be found [here](#).

***** Stochastic Processes and their Applications 2025**

The 44th Conference on Stochastic Processes and their Applications, will be held in Wrocław, Poland from 14 to 18 July 2025.

SPA Conferences are organised under the patronage of the Bernoulli Society <https://www.bernoullisociety.org/> and may be regarded as the most important series of international meetings on the theory and applications of stochastic processes.

***** Mathematical Congress of the Americas 2025**

The goal of the Mathematical Congress of the Americas (MCA) is to internationally highlight the excellence of mathematical achievements in the Americas and foster collaborations among researchers, students, institutions and mathematical societies in the Americas.

The fourth Mathematical Congress of the Americas, MCA 2025, will take place in Miami, Florida, USA; the dates are July 21-25, 2025.

***** First Joint Meeting Brazil-Mexico in Mathematics 2025**

To be held in Fortaleza, Brazil; the dates are September 8-12, 2025. The organizing committee of the First Joint Meeting Brazil-Mexico in Mathematics 2025 is now inviting proposals for thematic sessions. The deadline for submission is October 17, 2024. Our aim is to ensure strong mathematical representation from both Brazil and Mexico among the organizers and speakers for 20-25 thematic sessions.

Structure of a Thematic Session: Each session will consist of up to nine 30-minute talks focused on a specific area of pure or applied mathematics. Ideally, each session should be led by at least two organizers, with representation from both countries.

***** 65th ISI World Statistics Congress 2025**

The 65th ISI World Statistics Congress will be held October 5-9 2025 in The Hague, Netherlands. It takes place every two years, since 1887, and it represents the leading congress on statistics and data science worldwide. The programme will span the full field of statistics and data science including academia, business, industry, government and official statistics in line with the breadth of the ISI and the Associations affiliated with the ISI. ***** XVII Latin American Congress of Probability and Mathematical Statistics (CLAPEM)**

Promoted by the Latin American Society of Probability and Mathematical Statistics (SLAPEM) and the Latin American Regional Committee of the Bernoulli Society, is the main event in these fields in the region. It occurs every two/three years and attracts researchers and students from the most important Latin American centers. It has already been organized in Venezuela, Uruguay,

Mexico, Brazil, Chile, Argentina, Cuba, Peru, Colombia, and Costa Rica. The next edition will be held on March 2-6, 2026, in Montevideo, Uruguay.

*****International Congress of Mathematicians 2026**

Está abierta la convocatoria para organizar eventos y conferencias satélites al Congreso Internacional de Matemáticas 2026 que se llevará a cabo en Filadelfia, Estados Unidos, en julio de 2026.

Los eventos y conferencias podrán ser en los meses que van de mayo a septiembre del 2026 y tendrán que tener lugar en alguno de los tres países: Canadá, Estados Unidos o México.

La National Science Foundation (NSF) ha sido informada de que habrá un mayor número de solicitudes para eventos durante ese año y la Fundación Simons también podrá dar apoyos para algunos de los eventos.

El Comité de los eventos y conferencias satélites no dará apoyos económicos, solo aprobará bajo ciertos criterios qué eventos serán anunciados en la página del ICM, y por lo tanto serán reconocidos como eventos satélites.

Cada reunión tiene una presentación tipo coloquio sobre el área de investigación de una de las integrantes del grupo (40 min + 5 min de preguntas) seguida de charlas informales sobre algún tema relativo a la vida académica.
